- Every single incident of ragging, an FIR shall be lodged without exception, of the college authorities with the local police. In addition, one or any combination of the following punishments can be awarded:
- Cancellation of admission. 2.
- Suspension from attending classes. 3.
- Withholding / withdrawing scholarship / fellowship and other benefits. 4.
- Debarring from appearing in any test / examination or other evaluation process. 5.
- Withholding results. 6.
- Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, 7. tournament, youth festival, etc.
- Suspension / expulsion from the hostel. 8.
- Rustication from the institution for period ranging from 1 to 4 semesters. 9.
- Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution.
- 11. Collective punishment: When the persons committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment as a deterrent to ensure community pressure on the potential raggers.







- Ensure that victims or witnesses are not victimized or discriminated against while dealing with complaints of sexual harassment, and
- Ensure prohibition of retaliation or adverse action against a covered (e) individual because the employee or the student is engaged in protected activity.

Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)

This Mentorandum of Understanding (MoU) is made on this day of July, 2019.

BY AND BETWEEN

BHARATH Institute of Science and Technology, BHARATH Institute of Higher Education and Research having their registered office atNo.173, New Agaram Road, Chennai, Tamil Nadu 600073, India (here in after referred to as "BHARATH")

And

Bosch Limited, having their registered office at Hosur Road, Adugodi, Bangalore–560030, India and its sales office at Bosch Limited, 8/17 Shafee Mohamad Road Thousand Lights, Chennai (here in after referred to as "BOSCH")

BHARATH and BOSCH are individually referred as Party and jointly referred as Parties.

The Parties wish to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU), which is a renewal of the earlier agreement, for establishing BHARATH-BOSCH Joint Certification Program (hereinaffer referred to as "Joint Training Center") jointly developed by Bosch along with the BHARATH in the campus of BHARATH, Chennai upon the following understanding:

For BOSCH LIMITED

Authorised Signatory

FOR BHARATH INSTITUTE OF HIGHER EDUCATION & RESEARCH

- The proposed Joint Training Centre has been established by BHARATH as per the concept designed by BOSCH. The Joint Certification Program established will cover Tamil Nadu. It will act as the bridge to address the technological gap and focus on various technical training programs. This Joint Training Centre will enable training to the diploma, degree students and nearby industries (herein after referred to as "Program,").
- 2. BOSCH concept is the efficient combination of hardware, teachware and course ware which is offered by BOSCH as industry oriented training in the field of automotive technology.
- BHARATH with assistance of BOSCH (limited only to the assistance mentioned below) will maintain the premises for conducting training courses according to BOSCH concept.
- 4. BOSCH shall provide know how technology support, supply concept kits for different technologies with non-transferable limited usage licensed copies of teach ware and courseware, train the faculty as "TRAIN THE TRAINER" (TTT)in its training Centre in Bangalore as necessary, provide training methodologies in line with BOSCH concept , subject to terms and conditions mentioned here after.
- 5. BHARATH through the premises with BOSCH approved courses, will impart training to undergraduate, post-graduate, polytechnic, vocational school students to meet industry requirements, bridging the industry academic gap and enhancing the competency level of students for better employability. BHARATH will also provide industrial training to nearby industrial personnel; successful students will be awarded a joint certificate of BOSCH and BHARATH (Refer the Annexure-2).
 - 6. In consideration for BOSCH providing training assistance mentioned above, BHARATH agrees and undertakes to allow BOSCH unrestricted right to use the Joint Training Program Premises to directly impart training for BOSCH dealer network, OEMs, OECDs, STUs on cost sharing basis. It being clarified that for BOSCH, beneficiaries of BOSCH will provide its own certificates on Bosch specified format.
 - 7. For efficient running of the premises and to cover the recurring cost, it is recommended to charge nominal fees for the course and create a business model. The fee to be charged shall be shared between Bosch and BHARATH irrespective of the efforts as per the terms and conditions contained under Annexure—1.
 - 8. Institute shall conduct Training Courses for their Student and the no. of training days should not exceed 15 calendar days in a month.
 - 9. In relation to the implementation of the understanding concluded between the Parties as above, the Responsibilities with regard to each of the Parties for implementation of the understanding as mentioned above shall be as follows:

7.1 By BHARATH:

BHARATH will continue to Program without cost attached for

To identify the training modules and upgrade requirements in the premises

1. To appoint trainers and staff to work in this project

2. To provide training class room of 4000Sq.ft with 20 training chairs, Table and Chair for Trainer, also all the teaching aids like OHP, Laptop, Multimedia system etcetera

To provide a ventilated workshop are about 900 Sqft. with epoxy coating

- 4. BHARTH shall provide Stationary i.e notepad, pens for BHARATH student training.
- 5. Insurance for the premises given to Bosch for the institute will be taken care by BHARATH.
- 6. Electrical Charges will be shared as per actual consumption and sub meter to be installed by BHARATH.

7. Conduct at least 15 trainings every year from the recommended 8 training modules.

8. Train minimum 300 students / participants every year at "BHARATH - BOSCH Joint Training Centre" in BHARATH campus, Chennai.

Joint certification by Bosch & BHARATH will be awarded only for the students of BHARATH & all
other Educational Institutions to whom BHARATH provided training based on the training module
enumerated under Annexure 1 and approved by Bosch

10. To pay Bosch all fees applicable for each courses as enumerated under Annexure 1.

7.2 By BOSCH

- 1. To conduct "TRAIN THE TRAINER" course at the Bosch Training Centre, Bangalore.
- 2. To provide the equipment to BHARATH on loan basis for the period of agreement and the same shall remain the Property of BOSCH.

3. List of equipment as per Annexure -3

- 4. To provide all the Technical training material/documents in soft copy version on all Bosch Products.
- 5. To provide Front Board as well as wall charts of BOSCH systems at the Centre.
- 6. To provide web based training modules and training animations at the Centre.
- To help the Centre for making training documents and presentations.
- 8. To provide BOSCH training documents on BOSCH systems.

9. To provide training marketing with BOSCH network

- Bosch shall undertake the insurance for all the Bosch equipment installed at the Centre.
- 11. Electrical Charges will be paid by Bosch as per Actual consumption for the days where Bosch uses.
- 12. To provide details on commercials including the share in the training fees between BHARATH & Bosch, (Refer the Annexure-1)

The medium of the Training Documents (support from Bosch) will be in English only. All the above shall, however, is subject to BHARATH fulfilling all conditions mentioned under clause 7.1. Advanced & Expert courses will be conducted by Bosch alone.

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8. Intellectual Property Rights

- 8.1 With the prior written approval of Bosch, BHARATH shall be authorized to use the materials provided by Bosch during the term of this MoU. Such use is limited, however, to intimate the Training Courses to the Students and public in general who apply for the courses and subject to the guidelines and instructions of Bosch and not to be used for any other commercial purpose outside the scope of this MoU.
- 8.2 BHARATH acknowledges that the right to use the materials (over which Bosch has copy right) here in is for use in relation to the Bosch–BHARATH in Tamilnadu, India only
- 8.3 During the term of this MOU, BHARATH shall, with prior written permission of Bosch, advertise its association with Bosch for the purpose of advertising and promoting the Program and the Training courses. However, it shall only be in the manner permitted or as prescribed or instructed by Bosch.
- 8.4 BHARATH shall not, under any circumstances what so ever, use the teaching materials, tools (provided by Bosch and over which Bosch has proprietary rights) for any other purpose other than what has been detailed under this MoU.
- 8.5 BHARATH shall not, under any circumstances what so ever, modify and or alter any material and or impart any training which is in deviation of the courses designed by Bosch. Bosch shall not provide any certification in such a situation. If, however, BHARATH has breached the conditions of this provision and has not informed Bosch and Bosch being unaware issues certificates, in addition to its right to recall such certificate it shall also have the right to claim against BHARATH for breach and any kind of claim from a third party due to the exercise of a recall right by Bosch.

9. Duration, Amendment and Termination of the MoU

- 9.1 This MoU shall be valid for a period of three years from the Effective Date. During the period of its validity, the MoU can be amended anytime by mutual consent of both the parties in writing. The MoU can also be terminated by mutual consent or by either party giving the other a written notice of its desire to terminate the MoU by giving three months' notice in advance.
- 9.2 Not with standing any termination, the MOU shall continue to survive and be effective with regard to all rights and obligations of the Parties which existed prior to the termination of this MOU until such rights and obligations have been fulfilled into.
- 9.3 Promptly following the request of Bosch, at any time during the term of this MOU and or earlier termination, BHARATH will return to Bosch all materials provided to BHARATH in furtherance to the understanding between the Parties. Such exercise shall be undertaken by BHARATH within 30 days of receipt of such notice from Bosch.
- 9.4 Not with Standing anything contained above and or under any of the terms and conditions of this MoU in the parties in good faith continue their business understanding enumerated under this MoU even after expiry or early termination of this MoU, then such relationship shall be governed by the terms and conditions of this MoU until a fresh MoU has been executed.

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10. Dispute Resolution and Governing Law

- 10.1 The dispute or issue If any arising out of or touching this MoU if not resolved amicably shall be referred to an arbitration of an arbitrator mutually agreed by the parties. In the event, the parties fail to agree on single arbitrator then each party shall appoint one arbitrator and such arbitrators shall jointly appoint third arbitrator. The arbitration shall be governed by the Arbitration & Conciliation Act 1996 and the venue of the arbitration shall be in Bangalore. The language of the arbitration shall be English.
- 10.2 This MOU shall be governed by the laws of India and subject to arbitration, the courts of Bangalore shall have exclusive jurisdiction for all disputes under this MOU.

11. Miscellaneous

- 11.1 This MOU supersedes and replaces any and all prior agreements, understandings or arrangements, whether oral or written here to fore made between the Parties and relating to the subject matter here of, and constitutes the entire understanding of the Parties with respect to the subject matter of this MOU. This MOU may not be modified, changed, altered or amended except by an express written agreement signed by all Parties here to.
- 11.2 This MOU shall be executed in two counter parts, each of which shall be deemed as original but all of this together shall constitute one and the same instrument.
- 11.3 BHARATH here by shall indemnify and keep indemnified Bosch from and against all claims, demands, actions, suits and proceedings, what so ever that may be brought or made against Bosch on behalf of any person, body, authority whom so ever and what so ever and all duties penalties, levies, taxes, losses, damages, cost, charges and expenses and all other liabilities of what so ever nature which Bosch may now or thereafter be liable to pay incur or sustain by virtue of or as a result of the performance or non-performance or observance or non-observance by BHARATH of any of the terms and conditions of this MOU or otherwise

Memorandum of Understanding

for Institute-Industry Interaction

Between

(Bharath Institute of Higher Education & Research) Deemed University u/s 3 of UGC Act, 1956

And

Brahmastra Aerospace Systems

Bharath Institute of Higher Education & Research, a Deemed University located at 173, Agaram Main Road, Selaiyur, Chennai-600073 (hereinafter referred to as BHARATH INSTITUTE OF HIGHER EDUCATION & RESEARCH) and Brahmastra Aerospace Systems, (hereinafter referred to as BAe Systems), having its Registered office at 6/77, Balaraman street, Nanntangalam, Chennai-117, India having recognized the importance to Industry Oriented Training have, on this 15 September day 2021, entered into this agreement which witnesseth as follows:-

- BHARATH INSTITUTE OF HIGHER EDUCATION & RESEARCH is an Institution Deemed to be University by MHRD in July 2002, under section 3 of UGC Act 1956, providing multi-stream, multi-cultural and high-quality education.
- Brahmastra Aerospace Systems (BAe systems) Brahmastra Aerospace Systems is a start-up committed with a team of innovators, enthusiasts, and thinkers established in 2019 in Chennai. We came up together with the intention of providing STEM Education based on Aeronautics & Astronautics to students of various backgrounds. To create a platform for Research & Development in the field of Aeronautics, Aerospace & Defence System, so that we can exercise the current and advancing technologies in the mentioned fields and be a forerunner and self-reliant nation.

OBJECTIVE

The objectives of this interaction are many and would evolve with time and the quality of inputs provided by both the parties. At the outset the following can be envisaged.

- a) To provide interactions with the industry practitioners so as to have an understanding of industry expectations for the fresh graduates.
- b) To provide for regular knowledge exchange between institute and industry experts.
- c) To create opportunities to carry out Joint research & Consultancy for mutual benefit in areas where deemed necessary by both.

Hence Brahmastra Aerospace Systems & BHARATH INSTITUTE OF HIGHER EDUCATION & RESEARCH agree

- (i) To offer Real Time Projects to the final year Students: For this, Brahmastra Aerospace Systems identify Real Time projects in different areas for students of Aeronautical and Aerospace Engineering Programs (the distribution among the branches Brahmastra Aerospace Systems be made available well in advance to BIHER). Selection of these students BRAHMASTRA AEROSPACE SYSTEMS be completed at least two weeks prior to commencement of Projects at BRAHMASTRA AEROSPACE SYSTEMS.
 - a. Students for the Projects can be selected by BRAHMASTRA AEROSPACE SYSTEMS through a screening procedure.
 - b. BHARATH INSTITUTE OF HIGHER EDUCATION & RESEARCH BRAHMASTRA AEROSPACE SYSTEMS designates one of their Faculty Members as coordinators for students' projects to continuously monitor the progress of these Projects. BRAHMASTRA AEROSPACE SYSTEMS provide the list of Projects to BHARATH INSTITUTE OF HIGHER EDUCATION & RESEARCH on selection of students.

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- c. Both parties shall not use the name of the other in any advertisement or make any public announcement without the prior written approval of the other.
- d. Each party shall respect the others Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) and shall not use any trademark, copyright, design, symbol, or designation belonging to the other, without prior written approval of the other party.
- e. BHARATH INSTITUTE OF HIGHER EDUCATION & RESEARCH agrees that BRAHMASTRA AEROSPACE SYSTEMS is not obliged on account of this MOU to recruit/hire or train any fixed number of students from BHARATH INSTITUTE OF HIGHER EDUCATION & RESEARCH. However, BRAHMASTRA AEROSPACE SYSTEMS is requested to give priority for the students of Aeronautical and Aerospace Programs of BHARATH INSTITUTE OF HIGHER EDUCATION & RESEARCH in recruitment process.
- f. Both the parties shall maintain confidentiality in respect of any information, course material, plans, discussions, strategies or any material which shall be deemed to be confidential and shared between the parties. Further, BHARATH INSTITUTE OF HIGHER EDUCATION & RESEARCH agrees that BRAHMASTRA AEROSPACE SYSTEMS may request students who undertake Project Work in BRAHMASTRA AEROSPACE SYSTEMS to execute confidentiality agreements in order to protect any information exchanged by BRAHMASTRA AEROSPACE SYSTEMS with such students in this regard.
- g. It is acknowledged by the BHARATH INSTITUTE OF HIGHER EDUCATION & RESEARCH that the confidential information furnished by BRAHMASTRA AEROSPACE SYSTEMS are not disclosed, either in whole or in part, to any third party, either directly or indirectly, by agent, student, employee or representative. However, the confidential information furnished may be disclosed only to those faculties of BHARATH INSTITUTE OF HIGHER EDUCATION & RESEARCH connected with the activities pertaining to this MOU and they BRAHMASTRA AEROSPACE SYSTEMS be directed by BHARATH INSTITUTE OF HIGHER EDUCATION & RESEARCH to treat such information in accordance with the terms of this MOU. The provisions pertaining to confidentiality shall continue even after the termination of this MOU.
- h. Event 7: British - American words



- The Heads of Departments, the teaching and other staff shall be appointed in given time frame and selection shall be done according to procedures, qualifications and experience prescribed by the Council from time to time and pay scales shall be as per the norms prescribed by the UGC/AICTE from time to time.
- The Institution shall publish an information booklet before commencement of the academic year giving details regarding the Institution and courses / programs being conducted, academic calendar, fees charged and details of infrastructural facilities including faculty etc. in the form of mandatory disclosure on the Institute Website. The information shall be revised every year with updated information about all aspects of the Institute.
- 11. If the Institution fails to disclose the information or suppresses and / or misrepresents the information, appropriate action as per the notified regulations shall be initiated against the Institution.
- AICTE may also conduct inspections with or without notifying the dates to verify specific complaints, to verify adherence to AICTE norms & standards, and to verify any mis-representation, violation of norms & standards, mal-practices etc.
- 13. The Institution by virtue of the approval given by Council shall not automatically become claimant to any grant-in-aid from the Central or State Government.
- 14. In the event of a student / candidate cancelling the admission before the starting of the course, the wait listed candidates should be given admission against the vacant seats. The entire fee collected from the student, after a deduction of the processing fee of not more than Rs. 1000/- (Rupees one thousand only) shall be refunded to the student / candidate withdrawing from the program. It would not be permissible for the Institute to retain the School / Institution Leaving Certificates in original to force retention of admitted students and not to charge fees for the remaining period if a student cancels the admission at any point of time.
- 15. The Institution shall take appropriate measures for prevention of ragging in any form, in the light of AICTE regulation "Prevention and Prohibition of Ragging in Technical Institutions, Universities including Deemed to Universities imparting technical education" Regulation 2009 (F.No. 37-3/Legal/AICTE/2009 dated 01/07/2009). In case of failure to prevent the instances of ragging by the Institution, the Council shall take appropriate action as per the notified regulations.
- 16. Institution shall not conduct any UG/ PG/ Diploma Level Courses/ Programmes as mentioned in the Approval Process Hand Book through Distance Education/ ODL mode.

The Institution shall strictly follow further conditions as may be specified by the Council from time to time. The Council may withdraw the approval, in case it observes any violation of the above conditions and / or non-adherence to the norms and standards prescribed by the Council, mis-representation of facts and submitting factually incorrect information to it.
